

## 3 megawatt solar power plant cost Ivory Coast

Where will Ivory Coast's first solar power plant be located?

Ivory Coast is set to commission its first solar power plant in the country's northern town of Boundiali in the Savanes District, approximately 660km from the country's capital of Abidjan.

Will IPPs build solar power plants in Ivory Coast?

The selected IPPs will build solar power plants capable of delivering 60 MWp to the national grid in Ivory Coast. The solar plants are being built under the "Scaling Solar" program, an IFC initiative to leverage public-private partnerships (PPPs) for the rapid construction of solar power plants in developing countries, particularly in Africa.

Which companies are developing solar power plants in Ivory Coast?

The Egyptian company Elsewedy Electric is also among the potential developers of the Laboa and Touba solar plants. The same goes for Infinity Power Holding and Nareva Holding, the subsidiary of the Moroccan group Al Mada. The selected IPPs will build solar power plants capable of delivering 60 MWp to the national grid in Ivory Coast.

Is CIE launching a solar farm in the Ivory Coast?

CIE, the Ivory Coast's state-owned utility and subsidiary of French group Eranove, has recently completed the development of this solar farm in the Boundiali Department, Bangoué Region. The solar power plant is now set to supply clean electricity to 30,000 households in the region. But, its launch date is yet to be known.

How many projects are underway at the Boundiali solar power station?

To date, nearly 7,000 projects are underway." The Boundiali Solar Power Station was co-funded by a concessional loan of \$28.6 million from German investment and development bank, KfW, and a \$10.3 million grant from the EU, with the Government of Ivory Coast having committed the remaining \$3.5 million.

Will Côte d'Ivoire launch its first solar plant?

But, its launch date is yet to be known. Noumory Sidibé, the Director General of CIE said that Côte d'Ivoire is rich in renewable energy potential, and after having experimented with fossil fuels and hydroelectricity, the country is about to commission its first solar plant.
