

Should Afghanistan develop solar energy?

The Afghan government should consider developing solar energy as a priority for energy security, socio-economic development, and improving the quality of life in Afghanistan\*. Solar energy development is essential for any country's socio-economic development as most human activities are directly related to the sustainable meeting of energy demands.

Can solar power supply affordable electricity to Afghanistan's remote communities?

What percentage of Afghanistan's population has access to electricity?

In Afghanistan, only approximately 30.2 % of the population has access to the national electric grid. The access rate is approximately 88% for urban households and 11% for rural households. The electricity supply is not sustainable, and the level of access varies in different areas.

How much energy does a solar system produce a year?

In this scenario, solar modules produce 90,130 kWh/year, which corresponds to 85.5% of the total electricity production of the system. The wind turbines produce 15,334 kWh/year, which constitutes approximately 14.5% of the total production of the system.
