

Which energy storage technologies are included in the 2020 cost and performance assessment?

The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment provided installed costs for six energy storage technologies: lithium-ion (Li-ion) batteries, lead-acid batteries, vanadium redox flow batteries, pumped storage hydro, compressed-air energy storage, and hydrogen energy storage.

How many TWh of electricity storage are there?

Today, an estimated 4.67 TWh of electricity storage exists. This number remains highly uncertain, however, given the lack of comprehensive statistics for renewable energy storage capacity in energy rather than power terms.

How much does energy storage cost?

Assuming $N = 365$ charging/discharging events, a 10-year useful life of the energy storage component, a 5% cost of capital, a 5% round-trip efficiency loss, and a battery storage capacity degradation rate of 1% annually, the corresponding levelized cost figures are $LCOEC = \$0.067$ per kWh and $LCOPC = \$0.206$ per kW for 2019.

How long does energy storage last?

For example, pumped storage hydro (PSH) and compressed-air energy storage (CAES) primarily serve longer durations, but a duration of 4 hours at power levels of 100 MW and 1,000 MW are included to provide a comparison point at a shorter duration with other technologies and capture uses in projects developed in the past.

How many GW of energy storage are there in the world?

6.8 GW of energy storage globally (Figure ES8). Thermal energy storage applications, at present, are dominated by CSP plants, with the storage enabling them to dispatch electricity into the evening or around the clock.

How much does gravity based energy storage cost?

Looking at 100 MW systems, at a 2-hour duration, gravity-based energy storage is estimated to be over \$1,100/kWh but drops to approximately \$200/kWh at 100 hours. Li-ion LFP offers the lowest installed cost (\$/kWh) for battery systems across many of the power capacity and energy duration combinations.
