What drives the cost-effectiveness of long-duration storage technologies?

Can a 'zero-expansion' material last for ultra-long cycles?

However, even "zero-strain" materials with small unit-cell-volume changes of  $< 1\%$  cannot last for ultra-long cycles due to gradually accumulated intracrystal strain/stress.
