How much power does a powerpot generate?

All the PowerPot needs to generate power is heat and water. The PowerPot has a USB output and is currently available in two sizes, both of which were launched April 4th on the crowdsourcing site kickstarter.com. The PowerPot V is a backpacking model that produces up to 5W of electricity and weighs less than a pound.
