

GIE is offering an API service (Application Programming Interface) on its AGSI+ and ALSI transparency publication platforms at <https://agsi.gie> and <https://alsi.gie> which provides quick, continuous and direct access to the database and allows you to filter, create queries and export the data as required.

GIE members are active in the transmission, storage, and regasification of renewable and low-carbon gases, including natural gas and hydrogen, via LNG terminals. Gathering around 70 industry entities from 27 European countries, GIE perfectly embodies the multiple transitional decarbonisation pathways of the EU regions.

The Storage Database is the base of the Storage Map. It shows the operational data such as working gas volume, injection and withdrawal capacities of storage facilities as well as the under construction and planned storage sites. The database is available in an open format and includes also details on the operators and facilities.

The AGSI portal contains information about: daily natural gas stock in underground storages, daily injection / withdrawal quantities in / from the underground storages, total technical capacity and maximum ...

The GIE Storage Map provides comprehensive information on existing and under construction underground gas storage facilities in Europe, including working gas volume, withdrawal and injection capacity as well as other main characteristics. Planned or under study storage projects are also detailed.

According to AGSI, the storage transparency platform of Gas Infrastructure Europe (GIE), 95% of filling level can cover on average 28% of the EU's annual gas consumption<sup>2</sup>, with some variations at national level.
