

Who is responsible for alternative energy in Bolivia?

How can Bolivia improve energy production?

Bolivia continues to make efforts to upgrade the infrastructure needed for renewable energy production. The National Interconnected System (SIN), which the government has put in place, aims to improve the nation's capacity for producing electricity by building additional power plants, transmission lines and substations.

What type of energy system does Bolivia use?

Similar to the country's total energy system, the power sector relies heavily on natural gas (AETN, 2016). The electricity network in Bolivia is broken into two classifications: the National Interconnected System (SIN) and the Isolated Systems (SAs).

How much power will Bolivia have by 2025?

More recently, Bolivia's national electricity company (ENDE) projected that by 2025, 74% of the installed capacity will be from hydropower, 4% from non-hydro renewables energy, 12% from combined cycle plants, and 10% from thermal power plants (ENDE, 2016). These projections, though, only take into consideration the SIN.

The average electricity tariff in Bolivia in 2006 was lower than the Latin American average, at US\$0.0614 per kWh for residential users and US\$0.044 per kWh for industrial users. Bolivia has set ambitious targets for renewable energy sources, particularly hydropower, to meet its ...

Bolivia is making efforts in its electric sector, such as increasing the share of renewable energy and decommissioning inefficient power plants. However, these efforts remain limited when compared to the total national energy demand. Currently, more than 80% of internal energy consumption in Bolivia is of fossil origin.

The electricity sector in Bolivia is dominated by the state-owned ENDE Corporation (Empresa Nacional de Electricidad), although the private Bolivian Power Company (Compañía Boliviana de Energía Eléctrica; COBEE) is also a major producer of electricity. ENDE had been unbundled into generation, transmission and distribution and ...

The country's water sources are also threatened by melting glaciers. Bolivian cities get some of their water from glacial supplies, especially during dry months, and critics argue that the government has failed to secure alternative water sources. More than 40% of Bolivia's glaciers have melted in the last 20 years.

Current availabilities of lithium from the Uyuni Salt Lake show the great potential of this untapped resource so far in Bolivia, being an alternative to the development of LEV.
