

What are Antarctic ecosystem services?

Antarctic ecosystem services are rich and diverse and include global climate modulation, biodiversity and habitat protection, cultural heritage, scientific knowledge, education and recreation as well as the extraction of marine living resources.

Are es methodologies relevant in Antarctica?

However, as recognition of the high value of Antarctic ecosystems increases (Chown et al., 2015), application of ES methodologies becomes particularly relevant.

What are deep subglacial hydrologic systems in Antarctica?

Below these shallow hydrologic systems, Antarctic ice streams are expected to be underlain by sedimentary basins hundreds to thousands of meters thick that have the capacity to host substantial groundwater (6), constituting "deep" subglacial hydrologic systems, which we define here as groundwater below the glacial till.

What is an ES framework in the Antarctic Treaty System?

In the Antarctic Treaty System context, an ES framework can offer a valuable tool whereby different structural and functional elements of the ecosystems (e.g., net primary productivity and biomass) and the socio-cultural context (e.g., benefits and beneficiaries) are fully acknowledged and integrated in the decision-making process.

Is Antarctic es a socio-ecosystem?

However, Antarctic terrestrial and marine ES remain to be systematically assessed, mainly as a result of the history and legal particularities of the continent, but also in part due to the existing lack of supporting scientific knowledge and advice, from a socio-ecosystemic perspective, under the ES framework (see Pertierra and Hughes, 2019).

Why do Antarctic es need strategic management?

Consequently, the Antarctic ES providing units, i.e., the biotic and abiotic natural elements of ecosystems that provide multiple services (e.g., krill, penguins, ice-sheets, etc.), demand strategic management in order to satisfy all ES local and global beneficiaries and to achieve long-term sustainable use.

Antarctica is the coldest and driest place on Earth, and surrounds the South Pole. Tourist visits are costly, demand physical fitness, can only take place in summer (from November to February), and are largely limited to the Peninsula, Islands and Ross Sea. A couple of thousand staff live here in summer in some four dozen bases mostly in those areas; a small number stay over winter.
