

Antigua and Barbuda building energy control

What is the energy sector in Antigua and Barbuda?

The energy sector in Antigua and Barbuda is exclusively based on the combustion of fuel. There are no refinery processes active in Antigua and Barbuda, resulting in no fugitive emissions from primary and secondary fossil fuel production.

What is Antigua & Barbuda's energy policy?

Antigua and Barbuda's National Energy Policy sets out the Government's vision: 'Antigua and Barbuda will meet the energy needs of the present generation while safeguarding the environment and enabling future generations to meet their own energy needs'.

Can Antigua & Barbuda become energy independent?

Antigua and Barbuda can become energy independent, as it is technically possible. However, achieving this will require a significant political effort.

Will Antigua and Barbuda build a waste to energy plant?

Antigua and Barbuda intends to construct and operationalize a waste to energy (WTE) plant by 2025. By 2020, they aim to finalize technical studies for this project. In 2006, land use change and forestry contributed 7% of national emissions, which can be mitigated through the removal of GHG emissions by carbon sinks.

Is Antigua and Barbuda an economic powerhouse?

In 2014, Prime Minister Gaston Browne vowed to transform Antigua and Barbuda into an economic powerhouse and signed an agreement with Chinese investor Yida Zhang for USD 740m investments.
