What percentage of Argentine electricity is renewable?

What is the Argentine energy plan?

The broad objective is to ensure that the future Argentine productive structure is inclusive, dynamic, stable, federal, sovereign and environmentally sustainable. The plan entails significant investments for increasing renewable energy-based generation capacity, electricity transmission works and the gas pipeline network, among others.

How many solar farms are there in Argentina?

The solar farms are the 68.11-MW Zonda I, the 31.89-MW Zonda IB, the 17-MW Cura Brochero and the 8-MW Cura Brochero Ampliacion. The biogas power plant brought 3.12 MW. At the end of the second quarter, Argentina had 5,393 MW of installed renewable energy capacity across 202 operational plants.

How many lithium projects are in Argentina?

A recent analysis of the global industry found that 11 of the 42 lithium projects expected to begin production between 2022 and 2026 are in Argentina, more than any other country. Lithium exploration machinery works in the Arizaro salt flat, 3,460 meters above sea level. Anita Pouchard Serra
