

Can bamboo be used for bioenergy production?

In this Inbar Working Paper together with Jan van Dam, we provide an overview of the bioeconomic potential, technology options, challenges and opportunities of bamboo for bioenergy production, and provide recommendations for the strategic integration of bioenergy in the development of bamboo value chains for a circular bioeconomy.

Is bamboo a potential source of biomass energy?

Bamboo has been identified as a promising solution to the energy crisis and climate change as a source of biomass energy. Due to its rapid growth and high-value products, bamboo is considered as a potential source of biomass energy.

Do Indian bamboos have a carbon storage potential?

However, the biomass production and the carbon-storing potential of the Indian bamboos are largely unexplored. How much carbon does a hectare of bamboo absorb?

On an average, one hectare of bamboo stands absorbs about 17 tonnes of carbon per year. However, the biomass production and the carbon-storing potential of the Indian bamboos are largely unexplored. Can bamboo be used as a renewable resource in electrochemistry?

Bamboo, as a renewable resource, has potential applications in electrochemistry due to its numerous pore structures, short growth cycles, and easy processing [30,31]. In this work, we take full advantage of the natural hierarchical pore structure of bamboo and prepare self-supported porous carbon electrodes via the KHCO_3 one-pot activation.

How can bamboo be converted into energy?

Bamboo can be converted into energy through various pathways, such as acid-base pretreatment (Meng, Li, et al., 2022; Meng, Yang, et al., 2022), biodegradation (Song et al., 2022; Zhan et al., 2022), and steam explosion (Dai et al., 2022).
