

Why should Barbados invest in Arcalis?

What energy sources are used in the Arctic?

Electricity generation and installed capacity In the remote Arctic the most commonly used energy sources for electricity generation are diesel, followed by several mature renewable energy technologies such as hydropower, wind power, and photo voltaic (PV) power. In Section 3.2 the technologies used to harness energy are discussed in more detail.

Why is electricity cost so high in the Arctic?

All the afore mentioned factors result in high electricity cost for the end consumer. Renewable energy sources show their capability of reducing such impacts. Currently, hydropower is the most used power source of all renewable energy sources in the Arctic. Where hydropower resources are available, they can provide affordable electricity.

Is wind energy available in the Arctic?

Wind is a widespread energy source in the Arctic, with a high potential in coastal areas [56,57]. Wind potential is available throughout the year with seasonal variations. Wind energy can be harnessed using wind turbines and analysis (eg. Refs. [32,33]) has shown that a number of installed wind turbines can be found in the Arctic.

How does oil price affect electricity prices in Arctic communities?

It is likely that this drop in the oil price had an effect on the fuel cost in Arctic communities, and that this resulted in lower electricity prices. For example, in Hoonah, Alaska, the price of electricity fell from 65 USD /kWh in 2013, to 53 USD /kWh in 2018 as the data collection shows. 3. Energy technologies and socio-economic impact 3.1.
