BATREC is your partner to give a second life to your waste. We process batteries, mercury-contaminated wastes, liquid mercury and mercury absorbents for customers around the world.

How did batrec Industrie start?

The company's operations began in 1989 with the recycling of household batteries. At the time these contained considerable quantities of mercury, and as such Batrec Industrie acquired significant knowledge in handling this material.

Why did batrec Industrie build a new catalyst recycling plant?

In order to accommodate the clear demand in the market for such services, at the end of 2011 Batrec Industrie built a new catalyst recycling plant, which is currently running two furnace lines handling 1000 tonnes of catalyst and 3000 tonnes of active carbon.

Batrec Industrie AG has developed a special process for recycling EoL LIBs, which is made up of a combination of mechanical and hydrometallurgical processes and is depicted in Fig. 3. This schematic process scheme shows that LIBs are fed to a crusher for breaking up and energetic deactivation, which crushes them under a CO₂ protective gas ...

All BATREC's teams are trained in safe working practice supported by a behavioural safety programme. Our operational safety system is regularly tested and, when necessary, modified. All possible protective measures are continuously applied to reduce the risk of accidents and exposure that may be harmful to health.

These mercury-added products are generally collected by local authorities and then sent to BATREC for disposal, in accordance with the environmental laws in force. Some sites that used this metal in their process may nowadays need to ...

BATREC's processing unit can recycle any type of cell and battery. Alkaline, Zn-air, Zn-C batteries as well as button batteries. Alkaline, Zn-air, Zn-C batteries as well as button batteries. In addition, we can process Lithium batteries (eg LiMnO₂) or Li-ion batteries (Phones, E-bikes, electric vehicles, electric tools).

These mercury containing batteries are collected by local and national authorities and then sent to BATREC for recycling in accordance with current environmental legislation. The mercury contained in the batteries vaporizes during the first processing step by pyrolysis between 700 and 800°C. It will then be recovered and processed in our facility.

BATREC has carried out a wide range of projects throughout the world involving different types of mercury waste, activated carbon, mercury absorbents and batteries. To illustrate our global expertise, we provide the following case studies.
