

How do you protect a battery compartment?

A radiant energy detector and an automatic sprinkler system are required to protect the compartment [52]. Lithium-ion batteries and cells must be kept at least 3 m from the exits of the space they are kept in [52].

What are the storage requirements for a battery system?

In that regard, manufacturers storage requirements should be followed, charging circuit should be checked to be free from dust/liquid presence as well as the cool temperature in storage rooms/areas. However, for main battery system the storage requirements are included in SOLAS as batteries considered as hazardous risk source on board.

Can a battery compartment be isolated from a safe location?

(6) All ventilation and electrical systems within the battery compartment shall be capable of being isolated from a safe location outside of the battery compartment. Ventilation systems shall safely expel toxic or flammable gases to a safe location.

What should a battery compartment be made of?

Battery compartments Batteries should never be covered with plastic and synthetic sheets. Storage shelves must be made of a material resistant to that battery's electrolyte. Appropriate materials could be steel, wood, or plastic such as polyethylene and polypropylene [1].

2.5. End of life storage To avoid short-circuiting of the battery, all battery terminals must be secured by battery design methods or safe packaging [52]. Used and damaged batteries should not be kept in rooms or areas larger than 18.6 m<sup>2</sup> [52].

How should a battery compartment be monitored?

Temperature monitoring of the battery compartment is also recommended and this may be linked to early warning alarms as well as fixed fire suppression systems.
