How much will Puerto Rico spend on solar & battery storage?

SAN JUAN, Puerto Rico: The U.S. Department of Energy announced on December 12 that US\$365 millionwill be allocated to install solar and battery storage systems in homes and healthcare centers across Puerto Rico.

What is Puerto Rico's battery energy storage system?

The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's battery energy storage system is a 20,000kW energy storage project located in Puerto Rico. It was announced in 2018 and will be commissioned in 2020. The Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority owns the system (100%).

Does Puerto Rico need energy storage solutions?

"Isolated from typical supply lines, Puerto Rico needs solutions that reduce electricity costs, improve grid reliability, and accelerate renewable energy deployment," says DEPCOM Director of Energy Storage Nadja Gocek.

How much money will Puerto Rico spend on a solar system?

Of the total funds,up to \$190 millionwill go to Puerto Rico's Housing Administration and a private company to finance solar and battery systems in public housing common areas and subsidized multifamily housing properties. An additional \$175 million will be directed toward healthcare and dialysis centers.

What does Puerto Rico's \$175 million funding mean for health & dialysis centers?

An additional \$175 million will be directed toward healthcare and dialysis centers. This funding is part of ongoing efforts to address Puerto Rico's energy challenges, which chronic power outages have exacerbated.

Why did Puerto Rico get a power outage?

The announcement comes as the U.S. territory continues to struggle with chronic power outages that have worsened since Hurricane Mariapummeled the island as a powerful Category 4 storm in 2017,razing the electric grid. The outages also are blamed on a lack of maintenance and investment in its electric grid for decades.
