Is battery energy storage a new phenomenon?

Against the backdrop of swift and significant cost reductions, the use of battery energy storage in power systems is increasing. To minimise the risk of batteries becoming a fire hazard, a new British Standard covering fire safety for home battery storage installations came into force on 31 March 2024. The standard is - PAS 63100:2024: Electrical installations. Protection against fire of battery energy storage systems (BESS) for use in dwellings.
