

Who is bboxx solar?

The company's offering currently centers on small home solar panel systems. London-based off-grid solar company Bboxx has secured another \$50 million for its African and Asian operations after a series D funding round led by Japanese conglomerate Mitsubishi.

How many solar home systems does bboxx have?

So far, Bboxx has deployed more than 350,000 solar home systems. Bboxx has over 800 staff across nine offices including in Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Rwanda, and Togo, with its head office in the UK and its manufacturing operations in China.

How many solar home systems will bboxx install in Togo?

In July 2017 Bboxx announced plans to install 300,000 solar home systems in Togo after winning approval from president Faure Gnassingbe and three months later the company announced a \$5 million credit line from Deutsche Asset Management.

Where does bboxx install solar panels?

Bboxx supplies solar home systems in 12 countries across sub-Saharan Africa and in Pakistan and a spokesperson for the Instinctif PR firm said an announcement about moves into new markets would be made "in due course". Bboxx installs a solar panel which can power up to five lights, a television, radio, torch or a 12 V battery.

How does bboxx's solar home system work?

The Instinctif spokesperson told pv magazine "Bboxx's solar home systems are remotely monitored and the collection of data allows for proactive troubleshooting. An example of how this works in practice is that a technician can be scheduled to fix a depleted battery before it even becomes an issue for the customer.

How is bboxx transforming Africa's utility sector?

Following the successful acquisition of PEG Africa, Bboxx is making good progress on its ambition to transform the continent's utility sector through its increased presence in West Africa and by being a driving force behind access to goods and services for underserved communities.
