

How much energy does a data center use?

These estimates suggested that the worldwide energy use of data centers had grown from 153 terawatt-hours (TWh) in 2005 to between 203 and 273 TWh by 2010, totaling 1.1 to 1.5% of global electricity use (9). Since 2010, however, the data center landscape has changed dramatically (see the first figure).

How reliable are data center energy use estimates?

Bottom-up analyses tend to best reflect this broad range of factors, generating the most credible historical and near-term energy-use estimates (7). What is the future of backup energy storage?

What is data center power efficiency?

A key metric of data center power efficiency is measured by Power Usage Effectiveness (PUE), the ratio of the total annual energy to the annual energy used by the Information Technology (IT) equipment.
