Under its draft NECP (2023), Bosnia and Herzegovina aims to reach a share of 43.6% of renewables in final energy consumption by 2030 (up from 36.6% in 2021), including 70% for electricity, 61% for heating and cooling, and 8.4% for transport (46%, 53%, and 0.2%, respectively, in 2021).

As far as BiH's trade is concerned, the EU is the most important trading partner and accounts for 65% of the total trade volume. Switzerland currently ranks 11th in bilateral trade and 9th among foreign investors. Falling demand from the EU led to a decline in Bosnia and Herzegovina's industrial production.
