

Can solar power plants be used in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

From all Balkan countries, it was found that Bosnia and Herzegovina has one of the largest potentials for the implementation of solar power plants. It was estimated that energy produced from solar power plants could be 70.5 × 10⁶ GWh/year and the most suitable area is Herzegovina.

Is Bosnia and Herzegovina a good country for solar energy?

With around 60% of the land area, Bosnia and Herzegovina could have between 1.2 and 1.4 MWh/kWp of photovoltaic capacity compared to the world's solar potential. Compared to B&H and other Balkan countries, Serbia has a great potential for the implementation of solar energy.

What is the potential for bioenergy in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

Another significant factor that influenced the mass construction of solar power plants in Bosnia and Herzegovina is the introduction of the Institute of Virtual Power Plants, which came to life in practice in mid-2022. Thus, Bosnia and Herzegovina became the first country in the Western Balkans where virtual power plants are operational.

Bosnia and Herzegovina's state-owned power utility Elektroprivreda Republike Srpske (ERS) is seeking a 50-year concession from the government of the Serb Republic for the construction of a 53.6 MW solar power plant valued at 84.2 million marka (\$47.3 million/43.1 million euro) in Trebinje, local media reported on Tuesday.

Lar do Sol-Casablanca II Solar PV Park is a ground-mounted solar project which is planned over 700 hectares. The project is expected to supply enough clean energy to power 261,662 households, to offset 40,500t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO2) a year.

In 2012, Bosnia and Herzegovina established the first solar power plant (SPP) in the site called Kalesija. This

solar power plant generates a power of 120 kWh and the panels are distributed over 1200 m². Converted solar energy is sent to the Electric Power Industry of B& H. Its annual production counts 150,000 kWh of electricity.

The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) said on Wednesday it is extending a 25.1 million euro (\$27.7 million) loan to Bosnian power utility Elektroprivreda BiH [SAJ:JPESR] for the construction of two solar power plants with a total capacity of 50 MWp in Gracanica.

Elektroprivreda HZHB, one of the three state-owned power utilities in Bosnia and Herzegovina, operates hydropower plants and wind park Mesihovina, the country's first. It is determined to be in the top tier in solar power as well. It has just won approval from the Government of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina for a photovoltaic plant ...

The gross production of electricity in Bosnia and Herzegovina in 2022 is 16,384 GWh, of which 4,739 GWh or 28.9% was produced in hydropower plants, 10,706 GWh or 65.3% in thermal power plants, and in industrial power plants and others (wind and solar power plants) produced 939 GWh, i.e. 5.8% .
