What is the power sector in Botswana?

Revised in September 2020, this map provides a detailed overview of the power sector in Botswana. The locations of power generation facilities that are operating, under construction or planned are shown by type - including liquid fuels, gas and liquid fuels, coal, coal be methane, hybrid, hydroelectricity and solar (PV).

What is Botswana's primary energy supply?

Botswana's total primary energy supply (TPES) is fossil-based and largely reliant on oil products and coal, complemented by biomass and waste energy. A large proportion of TFEC comes from biomass energy in the form of traditional wood fuel (27.8%).

Where does Botswana get its power?

To meet its peak power demand, Botswana imports power from the Southern Africa Power Pool (SAPP) - mainly from South Africa - and when imports are not available, resorts to the use of costly backup diesel power plants.

Does Botswana have a good electricity supply?

According to Statistics Botswana, local electricity generation and distribution has showed a slight improvement, increasing by 10.2 percent from 807,943 MWh during the fourth quarter of 2022 to 890,655 MWh during the first quarter of 2023. The increase was attributable to the performance improvement of Morupule A and B power stations.

How is electricity generated in Botswana?

Currently, in Botswana electricity is primarily generated from domestic coal resources. Apart from coal-bed methane, there are no proven reserves of other possible fossil fuel resources for energy generation like natural gas or oil. Botswana has large coal reserves, estimated to be in excess of 200 billion tons.

Will Botswana be able to generate enough solar power?

In November 2018, BPC issued a Request for proposals relating to the development, financing, construction, operation and maintenance of 12 solar PV power projects. In a few years Botswana could be generating enough power internally to supply all of its domestic needs. General electrification is the main objective of the Government.
