

Are coal-fired power plants a good source of energy in Brazil?

Although Brazil has a high share of renewable generation, fossil sources still play a significant role, with coal-fired power plants contributing to large emissions. The Jorge Lacerda Complex is the largest coal-fired power plant in Brazil.

How many coal-fired power plants are there in Brazil?

Coal-fired power plants represent approximately 25% of emissions from the thermoelectric sector [21,22]. There are currently ten coal-fired thermal power plants in operation in Brazil, totaling 3.2 GW of installed power, mostly concentrated in the coal-producing South region [23].

What is the energy supply mix in Brazil?

Compared to the world, the Brazilian energy supply mix has huge participation of renewable sources, approximately 48%, related to emissions of around 400 Mt CO₂-eq in 2020 (EPE 2021b). As mentioned, in the electric sector, this participation is even bigger.

What percentage of energy is generated by coal in Brazil?

The share of coal in the Brazilian energy mix was 5.8% in 2018, accounting for 3.2% of total electric generation and 12.7% of thermoelectric generation [2]. Coal-fired power plants represent approximately 25% of emissions from the thermoelectric sector [21,22].

Can e-Kerosene production be integrated into Brazil's national energy supplies?

How much CO₂ does the energy sector produce in Brazil?

CO₂ emissions from the energy sector in Brazil were approximately 416 MtCO₂-eq in 2018 [2], with 49 MtCO₂-eq associated with emissions from thermoelectric power plants [203].
