

Why is electricity storage important in Brazil?

Electricity storage in Brazil The rise of renewable intermittent sources and the fall of stored energy in hydropower dams raises the risks associated to power security, but it can also pave the way for new technologies such as electricity storage [12].

Does Brazil need more energy in 2024?

Brazil's decennial plan for energy (2029) makes evident that more power will be required from 2024 onwards, suggesting that electricity storage can complement and enhance the system's capacity together with other well-established sources such as gas and thermal [26].

How will Brazil modernize the electricity sector?

The modernization of the electricity sector currently being discussed under Brazil's legislative power includes changes that are key to support the integration of storage into the system (e.g., separating electricity from capacity).

Can Utility-scale energy storage systems be used in Brazil?

Such challenges are minimized by the incorporation of utility-scale energy storage systems (ESS), providing flexibility and reliability to the electrical system. Despite the benefits brought by ESS, the technology still has limited investment and application in Brazil.

Is Brazil bringing storage into the energy transition?

Brazil is taking its first steps toward its ambitions of bringing storage into the energy transition of its electricity sector.

Does Brazil need energy storage regulations?

Specifically for Brazil, as shown in the results, there is no resolution that specifically addresses energy storage, even though some regulations currently in force may indirectly influence the adoption of ESS technologies, such as regulations for electric vehicles, differentiated hourly tariffs, among others.
