

Does Sungrow offer a 1+x modular inverter?

Sao Paulo, Brazil, October 29th, 2024 /PRNewswire/-- Sungrow, the global leading PV inverter and energy storage system provider, announced that it has supplied the project Vista Alegre with its cutting-edge 1+X Modular Inverter solutions to one of the Americas' largest PV projects -- a 902 MWp solar plant in Brazil.

Why is Sungrow Americas launching a solar project in Brazil?

Ada Li, Vice President of Sungrow Americas said: "This is one of the Americas' largest solar projects located in Brazil, a country with vast potential for further solar power generation, which offers energy security and independence and reduces carbon emissions in this vital decade for the clean energy transition.

How much solar power does Brazil have?

As of the end of March, Brazil's cumulative installed PV capacity had reached 41GW, of which 13GW were utility-scale PV projects and 28GW were distributed PV. Over the past decade, Brazil's solar power generation has shown phenomenal growth.

How much does solar energy cost in Brazil?

The average monthly electricity bill for a house in Brazil is R\$500, while the cost of installing solar energy on the roof is around R\$15,000, according to the price simulation table of the concessionaire Portal Solar. Due to the significant drop in module prices, the payback period for users has been significantly shortened.

How many solar PV contracts are there in Brazil?

Solar PV participates for the first time in the Leilão de Energia Nova A-4 auction, resulting in 20 large-scale solar PV power contracts. Solar PV reaches its first gigawatt (GW) of cumulative installed capacity in Brazil!

How many centralized PV projects are there in Brazil?

In terms of centralized PV, as of the end of June 2023, Brazil's installed capacity has reached 9.636GW, with 2.213GW of new capacity. The total installed capacity of ground-mounted PV reached 125.9GW, of which 9GW projects are already in operation, 6GW projects are under construction, and more than 107GW projects are ready for construction.

Analysis of Brazil's solar market. Brazil's solar market has been growing at a steady pace over the last ten years. As of February 2021, the country's cumulative installed solar capacity stood at approximately 8 Gigawatts. Nearly six months down the line, the South American nation has hit the 10 Gigawatts of the installed capacity mark.
