The Saudi Arabian power producer and developer has signed a joint development agreement with Gotion Power, Chinese battery manufacturer Gotion High-Tech's subsidiary in Morocco, for a 500MW wind power plant with 2,000MWh of battery energy storage system (BESS) technology.
