

What is Morocco's largest solar energy project?

Morocco has launched one of the world's largest solar energy projects costing an estimated \$9 billion. The aim of the project was to create 2,000 megawatts of solar generation capacity by 2020. The Moroccan Agency for Solar Energy (MASEN), a public-private venture, was established to lead the project.

What is the National Agency for solar energy in Morocco?

The law 57.09 voted in January 2010 creates the National Agency for Solar Energy, a leading institution to promote and manage the solar energy sector in Morocco. The agency will be entrusted with coordinating the National Integrated Project for Solar Electricity Production.

How much solar power will Morocco have by 2020?

The Noor plan, led by MASEN, aims to develop a minimum capacity of 2,000 MW of solar power by 2020 (equivalent to 14 per cent of Morocco's total installed electricity capacity by this date). This was expected to require more than 9 billion dollars of investment by 2020 and prevent the emission of 3.7 million tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub>.

Does Morocco have a solar energy plan?

Morocco has since pledged to increase the renewables in its electricity mix to 52% by 2030, made up of 20% solar, 20% wind and 12% hydro. In November 2009 Morocco announced a solar energy project worth \$9 billion which officials said will account for 38 percent of the North African country's installed power generation by 2020.

Will Morocco build a solar power station in Ouarzazate?

The Moroccan Agency for Solar Energy invited expressions of interest in the design, construction, operation, maintenance and financing of the first of the five planned solar power stations, the 500 MW complex in the southern town of Ouarzazate, that includes both PV and CSP. Construction officially began on 10 May 2013.

GIZ convinced the Moroccan Ministry of Energy and the Agency for Energy Efficiency to set up a varied portfolio of energy sources to include both solar and wind power for a number of reasons: favorable cost-benefit ratios for RE in Morocco, expected job creation, and CSP as a promising area for industrial development.
