In a significant step towards enhancing electricity supply and sustainable development, Burkina Faso signs an agreement for a 50 MWp solar power plant in Komsilga. Boucle de Mouhoun Solar PV Park is an 18MW solar PV power project. It is planned in Boucle du Mouhoun, Burkina Faso. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the financed stage.

This milestone was witnessed by representatives from the World Bank, the project financier; AMEA Power, the Middle Eastern energy developer and project owner; and the Burkina Faso Electricity Company, among other stakeholders. The Zina Solar PV Park is located in northwestern Burkina Faso and has a total installed capacity of 26.6 megawatts.
