

Are California's battery energy storage systems going up?

For Immediate Release: October 24, 2023 SACRAMENTO -- New data show California is surging forward with the buildout of battery energy storage systems with more than 6,600 megawatts (MW) online, enough electricity to power 6.6 million homes for up to four hours.

Should California increase battery storage?

Increasing storage allows California's grid to store energy from clean energy sources like solar during the day and use it during peak demand in the evening. Ramping up battery storage is a key part of Governor Newsom's energy roadmap for achieving the state's ambitious climate goals and a 100% clean electric grid.

How much battery storage does California have?

WHAT TO KNOW: California has increased battery storage by 757% in only four years, and now has enough to power 6.6 million homes for up to four hours - essential progress in cutting pollution, fighting climate change, and creating a more reliable grid.

Did California increase its battery storage capacity tenfold?

Governor Newsom joined state officials at a battery storage and solar facility in Winters to celebrate the milestone on Thursday during Earth Week. "In just five years, California has increased its battery storage capacity more than tenfold.

Where is the largest battery storage facility in California?

A battery storage facility under construction in Menifee, Calif., in March. The site, at 43 acres, is expected to be the largest in the state when completed.

Why is battery storage important?

Deploying battery storage is a critical component of the state's climate and clean energy goals. The state is projected to need 52,000 MW of energy storage capacity by 2045. Today, it's a quarter of the way there.

California now has 10,000 megawatts of battery power capacity on the grid, enough to power 10 million homes for a few hours. Those batteries are "able to very effectively manage that evening ...
