

How much electricity can a floating solar array produce?

Can floating solar power a water body?

Spencer co-authored a study in the December 2018 Environmental Science & Technology that assessed the technology's potential on 24,419 artificial water bodies in the continental U.S. It found covering just 27 percent of those water bodies with floating solar arrays could produce almost 10 percent of the nation's current power generation.

How does a floating cable work?

Floating or underwater cables carry direct current to an inverter on shore where it is converted to alternating current and sent to the local grid. Engineers must consider multiple factors: systems have to withstand high winds and waves, panels must be resistant to corrosion and anchors have to last for 25 years or more.
