How much space do pink jasmine plants require?

Should I repot a jasmine plant?

Repot the plant if the soil dries out quickly. Jasmine plants produce more flowers if their roots are not crowded (or "root bound"). If the plant's soil dries out after 2-3 days, transfer it to a larger pot or outside. It's also best to transfer your plant if it's been in the same pot for several years.

How does a jasmine plant spread?
