

How did China Help Africa build a power plant?

This project was supported by part of the Belt and Road Fund established by China in 2018, which allocated 6 trillion Kenyan shillings (KES) to help expand Africa's infrastructure construction capacity. China has helped to build over 80 big power facilities for Africa.

After the China-built plant went on the grid, Kenya's solar power generation jumped from 7.44 million kilowatts per hour (kWh) a month in 2021 to an average of 30 million kWh a month in 2023.
