

How big is China's Wind power industry?

Here is what we know about China's wind power industry. HOW BIG IS IT? China has by far the world's biggest wind turbine production capacity, or 60% of 163 gigawatts (GW) in 2023, says Brussels-based industry association Global Wind Energy Council. Production capacity in Europe and the United States, by contrast, stood at 19% and 9% respectively.

How is China's wind turbine sector doing?

The situation in China's wind turbine sector is similar to that in the solar sector, with massive domestic capacity increases underpinned by extensive government support, said Xuyang Dong, China energy policy analyst at Climate Energy Finance in Sydney.

Are Chinese wind turbines a threat to Europe's wind turbine industry?

European manufacturers such as Siemens Energy and Vestas, which predominantly supply Europe's wind turbines, are facing increased competition from Chinese companies. This poses a potential threat to their positions in the global market for the development of cost-effective and efficient wind turbines.

Are Chinese wind turbines cheaper in Europe?

The group has observed that Chinese turbines are being offered in Europe at prices up to 50% lower than those produced within Europe. Chinese manufacturers are also providing turbines with deferred payments, allowing wind farm operators to pay nothing until three years of revenue have been generated.

How many Chinese-made wind turbines are installed in Europe?

Around 2.6 GW of Chinese-made wind turbines are currently installed or planned to be installed in Europe according to Green Power Denmark. China is the world leader in wind power generation and boasts the largest installed capacity of any nation.
