

What is the demand for energy storage facilities in China?

The rapid growth of renewable energy generation has created a large market demand for energy storage facilities. By the end of the first quarter of 2024, the cumulative installed capacity of new energy-storage projects in China had reached 35.3 million kW.

How many energy storage projects are there in China?

According to CIAPS, there were 259 energy storage projects operating in China last year, with a combined capacity of 20.75GW. The energy storage sector is expected to maintain an annual growth rate of 55 to 70 per cent in the five years from 2021 to 2025.

China has added 21.5 GW of storage capacity so far this year, which is three times the amount added during the same period in 2022, accounting for 47 percent of the global increase, it said.
