

What is China's energy storage capacity?

China's energy storage capacity accounted for 22% of global installed capacity, reaching 46.1 GW in 2021 [5]. Of these, 39.8 GW is used in pumped-storage hydropower (PSH), which is the most widely used storage technology.

What will China's energy storage capacity look like in 2035?

From 2020 to 2035, the average annual growth rate of China's total installed energy storage capacity is expected to reach 8.3% (Pre-Co)-28.6% (Pre-Ef). SC (Pre-Co), lithium-ion batteries (Pre-Eq) and VRB (Pre-Ef) are expected to replace pumped Storage as China's leading energy-storage technology.

How will China's energy storage capacity affect its investment?

New power capacity and per investment cost affect the optimal annual investment in China's energy storage. It first increases and then decreases, reaching a peak of 10.7 million yuan around 2031 (BAU scenario).

What is the optimal energy storage investment in China?

Optimal new power capacity and investment for energy storage (2021-2035). The optimal annual investment in China's energy storage initially increased and then decreased under all the scenarios except H-S-Ma, reaching a peak of 4.2 million yuan (L-B-Mi) - 10.7 million yuan (BAU) in 2031 (Fig. 7 (b)).

What is China's Operational Energy Storage Project capacity?

Of this global capacity, China's operational energy storage project capacity totaled 32.7 GW, a growth of 4.1% compared to Q2 of 2019. Global operational electrochemical energy storage project capacity totaled 10,112.3 MW, surpassing a major milestone of 10 GW, an increase of 36.1% compared to Q2 of 2019.

How did China's electrochemical energy storage capacity compare to Q2?

Of this capacity, China's operational electrochemical energy storage capacity totaled 1,831.0 MW, an increase of 53.9% compared to Q2 of 2019. Both in the global and Chinese markets, electrochemical energy storage capacities showed growth compared to their respective Q2 period in 2019, at 1.4% and 1.8%, respectively.

2. Market Developments

In the past two years, countries around the world have outlined blueprints for achieving carbon neutrality by 2050 or 2060 [1,2]. To effectively promote the low-carbon transformation of the energy system, there is a need
