

Colombia's energy storage deployment scale

Where is a lithium-ion battery project located in Colombia?

Located in the city of Barranquilla in northern Colombia, this project will consist of a 45 MWh lithium-ion battery energy storage system and is expected to reach commercial operation by June 2023. The project is granted with a 15-year revenue structure with the Colombian government and is indexed to the country's inflation or producer price index.

Why is battery storage important in Colombia?

An initial auction for battery storage was successful to optimise the use of the transmission grid. Colombia has a largely decarbonised power sector thanks to the significant role of hydropower and bioenergy.

How does the IEA support Colombia's energy transition?

The IEA supports Colombia's agenda for a just energy transition. Experience from the IEA's Global Commission on People-Centred Transitions provides useful learnings for the government of Colombia, helping to boost local economic benefits and the transition to clean energy and new job opportunities.

Will electricity storage benefit from R&D and deployment policy?

Electricity storage will benefit from both R&D and deployment policy. This study shows that a dedicated programme of R&D spending in emerging technologies should be developed in parallel to improve safety and reduce overall costs, and in order to maximize the general benefit for the system.

What percentage of Colombia's energy is renewable?

In 2021, renewable energy accounted for 25% of Colombia's total energy supply and for 29% of final consumption, substantially above the IEA average of 14% and made up 75% of electricity generation (compared to the IEA average of 30%).

Does Colombia have a decarbonised power sector?

Colombia has a largely decarbonised power sector thanks to the significant role of hydropower and bioenergy. Electricity demand is expected to increase as a result of economic growth and the electrification of end-use sectors, an opportunity to decarbonise the transport sector over time.
