How efficient is an underwater compressed air energy storage system?

An underwater compressed air energy storage (UWCAES) system is integrated into an island energy system. Both energy and exergy analyses are conducted to scrutinize the performance of the UWCAES system. The analyses reveal that a round-trip efficiency of 58.9% can be achieved.

What is compressed air energy storage?

Compressed air energy storage (CAES) is one of the many energy storage options that can store electric energy in the form of potential energy (compressed air) and can be deployed near central power plants or distribution centers. In response to demand, the stored energy can be discharged by expanding the stored air with a turboexpander generator.

Where is compressed air stored?

Compressed air is stored in underground caverns or up ground vessels,. The CAES technology has existed for more than four decades. However, only Germany (Huntorf CAES plant) and the United States (McIntosh CAES plant) operate full-scale CAES systems, which are conventional CAES systems that use fuel in operation ,.

What happens when compressed air is removed from storage?

Upon removal from storage, the temperature of this compressed air is the one indicator of the amount of stored energy that remains in this air. Consequently, if the air temperature is too low for the energy recovery process, then the air must be substantially re-heated prior to expansion in the turbine to power a generator.

Can underwater gravity energy storage be used to store compressed air?

Samadi-Boroujeni have proposed to use underwater gravity energy storage to isothermally and efficiently (>50%) store compressed air for later electricity generation. A similar energy storage proposal that has been receiving substantial attention is underwater compressed air storage.
