

# Cost analysis of various new energy storage

Which energy storage technologies are included in the 2020 cost and performance assessment?

The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment provided installed costs for six energy storage technologies: lithium-ion (Li-ion) batteries, lead-acid batteries, vanadium redox flow batteries, pumped storage hydro, compressed-air energy storage, and hydrogen energy storage.

Are energy storage systems cost estimates accurate?

The cost estimates provided in the report are not intended to be exact numbers but reflect a representative cost based on ranges provided by various sources for the examined technologies. The analysis was done for energy storage systems (ESSs) across various power levels and energy-to-power ratios.

How do we predict energy storage cost based on experience rates?

Schmidt et al. established an experience curve data set and analyzed and predicted the energy storage cost based on experience rates by analyzing the cumulative installed nominal capacity and cumulative investment, among others.

How much do electric energy storage technologies cost?

Here, we construct experience curves to project future prices for 11 electrical energy storage technologies. We find that, regardless of technology, capital costs are on a trajectory towards US\$340 /MWh for installed stationary systems and US\$175 /MWh for battery packs once 1 TWh of capacity is installed for each technology.

How important are cost projections for electrical energy storage technologies?

Cost projections are important for understanding this role, but data are scarce and uncertain. Here, we construct experience curves to project future prices for 11 electrical energy storage technologies.

What are energy related costs?

Energy related costs include all the costs undertaken to build energy storage banks or reservoirs, expressed per unit of stored or delivered energy (EUR/kWh). In this manner, cost of PCS and storage device are decoupled to estimate the contribution of each part more explicitly in TCC calculations.
