

Does Laos have a solar power plant?

In addition to hydropower, Laos has also been exploring other renewable energy sources, such as solar and biomass. The country's first large-scale solar power plant, with a capacity of 10 MW, was commissioned in 2018, and several other solar projects are currently under development.

How much solar power does Lao PDR have?

Lao PDR has an average of 200-300 sunlight days per year, with a potential capacity of solar energy of 4.5-5.0 kWh/m² per day. Solar power, while not the main energy source, has incredible potential to play a critical role in off-grid electric power for remote rural areas.

Why is solar energy important in Laos?

Laos is undergoing rapid socio-economic changes and the provision of sufficient energy is an important factor in the response to continuing development. "Given recent advances in solar energy in Laos, it has become clear that more and more local and foreign businesses are interested in investing in this field," Daovong said.

How much electricity will Laos produce by 2030?

These developments will support government efforts to increase the amount of energy exported and minimize the amount of electricity re-imported from neighboring countries in the dry season. By 2030, it is planned that Laos will produce another 5,559 MW of electricity.

How much power will Laos have?

Of this amount, 77.59 percent will come from hydropower and the rest will come from solar, wind and coal-fired power plants, said the report. Laos' capacity for solar power is expected to range from 10,000 MW to 15,000 MW, while wind power potential is estimated at about 100,000 MW, according to the report. ?

How is Laos promoting hydropower development?

The Lao government has been actively promoting hydropower development, both for domestic consumption and for export to neighboring countries, such as Thailand, Vietnam, and Cambodia. In addition to hydropower, Laos has also been exploring other renewable energy sources, such as solar and biomass.

Every year the Lao PDR receives a significant amount of hard currencies from those power exports. This is widely considered to be one of the driving forces to boost socioeconomic development and energy security in the country. The Lao PDR's total final energy consumption (TFEC) grew by 2.7% from 2010 to 2018 (Figure 10.1).

As the junta struggles with constant power shortages and increasing gas costs, local companies have turned to solar to fill the gap. Current Solar Power Project and Expansion Plan: EDLGEN - Solar Power First Project is located at Chaengsavang village, Naxaithong district, Vientiane capital, 2017. According to the agreement between EDL and EDL-Gen Solar Power Limited, solar power electricity generation with 100 megawatts are set for 2 phases:

It is almost 30% less expensive than natural gas and almost 80% less expensive than solar power. The low cost of imported Laos hydropower drives the market. In 2019 and 2020, the cost of Laos hydroelectricity was slightly lower than Thailand's average electricity production price and made up close to 10% of Thailand's total electricity ...

This Solar Power Project is the first Solar Farm in Laos, utilizing modern technology such as solar panels from TALESON, with a capacity of 320 Watt per panel. About 9,600 panels were installed and connected to 22 kV transmission line system of Electricity Du Laos. The total project cost is USD 3,445,306 Million or approximately 27 Billion Kip.

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
