When will DR Congo's solar power plants be built?

The plants are to be built by the Moyi Power joint venture and are expected to be completed within 18 months after the start of construction. According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020.

How many Solar Ambassadors are there in the DRC?

Goma hybrid solar project in the Democratic Republic of Congo According to the World Bank, only 19% of the DRC's around 102 million people have access to electricity. This translates to about 41% in urban areas and 1% in rural areas.

How much power does DR Congo have?

According to the latest figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency, DR Congo only had 20 MW of installed PV capacity at the end of 2020. The country has one of the lowest levels of access to electricity in the world, with only 9% of the population being supplied with power. This percentage in rural areas drops to as far as 1%.

Where is Nuru solar based?

Nuru deployed Congo's first solar-based mini-grid in 2017 and has a 1.3MW solar hybrid site in Goma, the largest off-grid mini-grid in sub-Saharan Africa. Another solar hybrid site in Beni and two in the oriental province (Tadu & Faradje). Nuru was first established under the name Kivu Green Energy in August 2015.

Is Nuru the world's largest off-grid solar metrogrid?

Nuru was the first company in DRC to deploy a solar mini-grid, built the largest fully off-grid solar hybrid metrogrid in Sub-Saharan Africa in 2020, and is now seeking to provide 5 million clients with world-class connectivity in the country.

As stated by Soleos Energy CFO Jason Temasfieldt, the company seeks to implement up to 1 GW of solar projects in the country. According to local media reports quoting DR Congo's minister of foreign trade, Julien Paluku Kahongya, the current project is the pilot phase of a 500-MW scheme.

As many as 10 Indonesian companies are to team up with a United States-based construction service provider, Sandi Group Global Holdings, to do business in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

Soleos Energy is partnering with Melci, an electrical engineering company in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), to construct a 200 MW solar PV power project.
