

How can data centers meet increased electricity demand?

Today, solar energy, land-based wind energy, battery storage, and energy efficiency are some of the most rapidly scalable and cost competitive ways to meet increased electricity demand from data centers.

How much energy does a data center need?

These facilities need eye-popping amounts of power. Serving a 1-gigawatt data center requires the capacity of about four natural gas plants or around half of a large nuclear plant. All told, meeting global data center demand could cost more than \$2 trillion in new energy generation resources, according to Bain estimates.

How can data centers reduce energy consumption?

Energy efficiency is a key tool in reducing energy consumption from data center facilities. DOE has long been a leader in developing improved cooling technologies, including for data centers. For instance, ARPA-E has an ongoing COOLERCHIPS program focused on commercializing innovative cooling technologies for data centers.

Do data centres contribute to global electricity demand?

Nonetheless, electricity demand from data centres is set to grow strongly to 2030 under today's policies settings and trends. However, when considered in a broader context of total electricity consumption growth globally, the contribution of data centres is modest.

Will data centres be impacted by a surge of demand?

There have already been instances of jurisdictions pausing new contracts for data centres due to a surge of requests. For regions or countries that are particularly affected, rising electricity consumption from data centres could make meeting their climate targets more difficult.

How can data centres be more transparent?

New cooling technologies are being developed, and AI models themselves are becoming more efficient. At the same time, the operational and energy performance of data centres is relatively opaque, making demand estimates difficult. Efforts are underway to improve transparency in some jurisdictions.
