

How do dna data storage systems work?

Most DNA data storage systems use short sequences or 'addresses' written into strands of each file for retrieval. These addresses typically are complementary to short DNA oligomers used to amplify the files through PCR ³ or to extract them through affinity-based methods ⁵⁵.

How much data is stored in DNA synthesis?

While stored data size has been markedly increased, the current record for DNA digital data storage is still around 200 MB, with single synthesis runs lasting about 24 h. (8,12) Achieving the storage of TBs of data at a low cost is unattainable with the current techniques.

Can DNA be used for next-generation data storage?

DNA has become a promising tool for next-generation data storage since it provides high data capacity and storage density (78) and it is possible to store it in multiple ways (37) over significant time periods. (4) However, in order to make DNA data storage standard, some limitations must be overcome.

What are the advantages of DNA compared to other data storage devices?

In addition to its stability and low cost of storage, DNA presents a major key advantage compared with existing data storage devices: data density.

What are the limitations of DNA data storage?

Arguably, the most important limit to the development of DNA data storage is cost, especially in comparison with standard storage processes. Often, synthesis costs for DNA data storage are undisclosed; (12) however, it is possible to draw some conclusions about them.

What are the applications of DNA data storage & manipulation?

Finally, we also highlight the exciting potential applications of DNA data storage and manipulation, including archival storage, barcoding, cryptography, (11) and DNA computing. Despite the hurdles that must be surmounted to implement DNA data storage, it is important to remember that DNA plays an irreplaceable role in biological systems.
