

What are surface mount tantalum capacitors used for?

Surface mount tantalum capacitors are used for power supply filtering in computer motherboards and cell phones due to their long-term stability and small size. Tantalum electrolytic capacitors are suitable for storing electrical energy and also for passing or bypassing low-frequency signals due to their large capacitance.

The low leakage and high capacity of tantalum capacitors favor their use in sample and hold circuits to achieve long hold duration, and some long duration timing circuits where precise timing is not critical.

Solid polymer tantalum electrolytic capacitors do have a life time specification. Indeed, the polymer electrolyte has a slight deterioration of conductivity by a thermal degradation mechanism of the conductive polymer.

How were tantalum capacitors made?

They ground metallic tantalum to a powder, pressed this powder into a cylindrical form and then sintered the powder particles at high temperature between 1,500 and 2,000 °C (2,730 and 3,630 °F) under vacuum conditions, into a pellet ("slug"). These first sintered tantalum capacitors used a liquid electrolyte.

Does a tantalum capacitor leak if reverse voltage exceeds 10 %?

Indeed, researchers have obtained that leakage currents of a tantalum capacitor rapidly increase if the applied reverse voltage exceeds 10 % of the DC rating. 1.3.1.2.
