

What is integrated water storage planning?

The proposed integrated water storage planning framework is grounded in sustainable development and climate resilience, with the potential to pay dividends for people, economies, and environments for generations.

What is the difference between a driven well and a dug well?

Dug wells are normally circular in shape (Figure 9.6). This type of well is sometimes capable of drawing sufficient supplies of water from shallow sources but is easily polluted by surface water. Driven wells are like dug wells, in the sense that they tap the shallow portion of the unconfined aquifers (Figure 9.7).

What should be considered in a water storage system?

(j) Where water is only available intermittently or supply pressures are low, provision of storage should be considered. (c) Satisfactory pressure at the WP/water points should be provided for: The minimum static head should be not less than 6m and the maximum 25m.

Is water storage a siloed facility?
