However, the rapid growth in large-scale battery energy storage systems (BESS) is occurring without adequate attention to preventing fires and explosions. That by the end of 2023, 10,000 megawatts (MW) of BESS will be energizing U.S. electric grids--10 times the cumulative capacity installed in 2019.

How are overlapping crises affecting Africa's Energy Systems?

The overlapping crises are affecting many parts of Africa's energy systems, including reversing positive trends in improving access to modern energy, with 4% more people living without electricity in 2021 than in 2019. They are also deepening financial difficulties of utilities, increasing risks of blackouts and rationing.

Are African savanna fires a global problem?

African savanna fires account for over 60% of global fire extent and are responsible for approximately 71% of global savanna CO₂ emissions (UNU-IAS 2015; Maraseni et al. 2016).
