According to the Lenz's law, the magnitude of the reaction magnetic field generated by the eddy currents is opposed to the variation of the main magnetic field that generated them.

The magnetic fields induced by eddy currents can also be used in medical applications. The induced magnetic fields can be used to solve bioelectromagnetic problems. Eddy currents find specific applications in the bio-electromagnetic study of the human brain, as documented in references [18,19,20].
