

How much do electric energy storage technologies cost?

Here, we construct experience curves to project future prices for 11 electrical energy storage technologies. We find that, regardless of technology, capital costs are on a trajectory towards US\$340 /MWh; 60 kWh /M for installed stationary systems and US\$175 /MWh; 25 kWh /M for battery packs once 1 TWh of capacity is installed for each technology.

How much does energy storage cost?

Assuming  $N = 365$  charging/discharging events, a 10-year useful life of the energy storage component, a 5% cost of capital, a 5% round-trip efficiency loss, and a battery storage capacity degradation rate of 1% annually, the corresponding levelized cost figures are LCOEC = \$0.067 per kWh and LCOPC = \$0.206 per kW for 2019.

How can EES technology reduce energy costs?

Generally, large-scale EES technologies that have decoupled energy and power characteristics have lower costs for longer duration with optimized system designs; while for shorter duration storage applications, batteries could further reduce the cost by learning-by-doing and potentially using chemistries with earth-abundant raw material.

Can electrical energy storage solve the supply-demand balance problem?

As fossil fuel generation is progressively replaced with intermittent and less predictable renewable energy generation to decarbonize the power system, Electrical energy storage (EES) technologies are increasingly required to address the supply-demand balance challenge over a wide range of timescales.

Is battery storage a cost effective energy storage solution?

Cost effective energy storage is arguably the main hurdle to overcoming the generation variability of renewables. Though energy storage can be achieved in a variety of ways, battery storage has the advantage that it can be deployed in a modular and distributed fashion<sup>4</sup>.

What are the economic benefits of storage capacity?

In the context of residential behind-the-meter storage, the economic benefit of storage capacity is that it yields a price premium, given as the difference between the retail electricity price and the overage tariff that is obtained for surplus energy generated by the solar PV system but not self-consumed.
