The heating engineer will remove the existing boiler, taking out the flue and condensate pipes - which aren't needed as electric boilers don't produce waste gases - and then either capping the gas line or completely removing the oil storage tank. The same heating engineer should then be able to install the new electric boiler onto the wall.

How much electricity does an electric boiler need?

Boilers ranging from 18 to 24kW require a 400V three-phase supply for operation. It's always best to consult a qualified electrician to assess your overall power requirements and determine the appropriate electricity supply (single-phase or three-phase) for your electric boiler installation.
