

Are electric vehicle battery fires dangerous?

Despite these incidents, electric vehicle battery fires are rare. Indeed, the available data indicate the fire risk is between 20 and 80 times greater for petrol and diesel vehicles. Fire risks are also greater for electric scooters and electric bikes. However, battery fires do pose particular problems, which I'll discuss later.

Why are electric cars so dangerous?

He said issues often arise when there is damage to the battery system or it isn't properly stored. "The challenge is when these electric vehicles do light on fire, they can create quite an unsafe area because these battery fires can even create an explosion risk and they can emit very toxic gases and chemicals," Dr Priestley said.

Are EV fires a hazard?

With an increased number of cells and higher energy batteries comes a greater risk during failure. Specific numbers on EV fires are challenging to pin down. The National Fire Incident Reporting System, or NFIRS, used by fire departments, hasn't historically separated gasoline car fires from those involving electrified vehicles.

Are electric cars a fire hazard?

The Tesla report notes National Fire Protection Association data for the United States showed a much higher rate of one fire for every 19 million miles (30.6 million kilometres). We still have limited data on fire risk in electric vehicles, most of which are relatively new.

Are EV batteries dangerous?

"The challenge is when these electric vehicles do light on fire, they can create quite an unsafe area because these battery fires can even create an explosion risk and they can emit very toxic gases and chemicals," Dr Priestley said. One of the biggest problems was extinguishing a fire once an EV battery system caught alight.

How many electric car fires have been reported in Australia?
