Do kitchen island outlets need receptacles?

However, they often lack essential electrical outlets, which can hinder their usefulness. The National Electrical Code (NEC) requires at least one receptacle for the first nine square feet of countertop space on an island, with additional outlets for larger areas. The NEC specifies the following requirements for kitchen island outlets:

Does the 2023 NEC require receptacles on kitchen islands?

In a major departure from previous years, the 2023 NEC does not require receptacles on kitchen islands or peninsulas, but there's a caveat. As Hannas paraphrases: "If a receptacle outlet is not provided for islands and peninsulas, provisions must be provided for the addition of a receptacle outlet in the future."

How do you install a receptacle on a kitchen island?

Turn off the power to the kitchen area at the main breaker panel. Locate the existing electrical box or wires within the island. Use the electrical toner to trace the wires back to their source if necessary. Choose an ideal location for the new receptacle, typically on the end of the island away from seating areas.

Can a kitchen receptacle be installed on a peninsula?

If you go this route, keep in mind that wiring provisions still need to be provided at the island or peninsula for the future installation of receptacles. The best option is to run one of the 20-amp kitchen circuits to the interior of the island or peninsula base cabinets to power future receptacles.

What if a receptacle outlet is not provided for Islands?

As Hannas paraphrases: "If a receptacle outlet is not provided for islands and peninsulas, provisions must be provided for the addition of a receptacle outlet in the future." A common way to do this is to run wires to a junction box located inside a cabinet under the countertop.
