In December 2015, Bapco Energies signed an agreement with Teekay Corp., a Canadian-based petroleum shipping firm, to build a liquified natural gas (LNG) import terminal in Bahrain. To fund this project, Bapco Energies issued US\$570 million in sukuk (bonds which are sharia-compliant) in March 2016. Some of the

funds were also used for modernization projects at Bahrain Petroleum Company (BAPCO) and at Bahrain's natural gas processing plant. Bapco Energies formed a joint venture
